According to the International Air Transport Association (IATA), the average cost of jet fuel worldwide in January was 5.4% higher than it was in December and 33.1% higher than it was a year earlier.

IATA agrees in its latest airline financial monitor, issued in January, that the political turmoil in Egypt “and fears of a domino effect on other oil producing states in the region” drove crude oil prices above \$100 a barrel, more than \$20 a barrel higher than the 2010 average. At that time jet fuel prices had reached \$113 a barrel, considerably higher than the \$91 a barrel average for 2009.
